


# Hand-Penned Diagonal Split Panel Thank You Card



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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Hand-Penned Petals (155070)
- **Card Stock (CS)** – Garden Green (102584); Basic White Thick (159229)
- **Ink Pads** – Garden Green (147089); Pale Papaya (155670); Misty Moonlight (153118); Black Memento (132708)
- **Misc.** – Penned Flowers Dies (155557); Hand Penned Designer Series Paper (DSP) (155499); Pale Papaya Stampin' Blends Marker (155519); Misty Moonlight Stampin' Blends Marker (153108); Shaded Spruce Stampin' Blends Marker (154903); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Foam Adhesive Sheets (152815); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Bone Folder (102300); Paper Snips Scissors (103579); Loose Flower Flourishes (155808); Paper Trimmer (152392); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); pencil & eraser

## Measurements:

- Basic White Thick CS: 4-1/4" x 11", scored in half at 5-1/2"
- Basic White Thick CS: 3-3/4" x 5"
- Basic White Thick CS: scraps for die cutting
- Garden Green CS: 4" x 5-1/4"; 3-3/4" x 5"
- DSP: 3-3/4" x 5"

## Instructions:

1. On the 3-3/4" x 5" Basic White Thick CS layer, make a pencil mark along the left side 1/4" from the top, and 2-1/2" from the top. Then make a pencil mark along the right side at 3-1/2" from the top, and 4-1/4" from the top.

2. Lay this layer on top of the Garden Green CS layer of the same size, lining them up.  
This is so you can cut both layers at the same time so they'll be exactly alike.
3. Cut from the top left mark to the top right mark.
4. Cut from the bottom left mark to the bottom right mark.
5. You don't need the pieces you cut from the middle, only the top and bottom.
6. Erase all visible pencil marks.
7. Stamp the flower cluster in Black Memento ink onto a scrap of Basic White Thick CS, and color in using Stampin' Blends Markers.
8. Stamp the other flower in Garden Green and Misty Moonlight.
9. Cut both stamped images using the Penned Flowers Dies.
10. Using Paper Snips, cut the two flowers in the cluster apart, then glue together so they overlap.
11. Glue the Mist Moonlight flower onto the back of the cluster.
12. Stamp the sentiment in Pale Papaya ink onto the upper diagonal layer, then stamp over it in Misty Moonlight, offset just a tiny bit.
13. Lay the top Basic White layer on the top Garden Green layer, and slide it up until 1/8" of the Garden Green layer shows along the diagonal. Glue them together.
14. Lay the bottom Basic White layer on the bottom Garden Green layer, and slide it down until 1/8" of the Garden Green layer shows along the diagonal. Glue them together.
15. Using a Foam Adhesive Sheet cut to size, adhere the two diagonal layer stacks onto the DSP layer, lining up the top, bottom, and sides.
16. Glue the DSP layer onto the larger Garden Green CS layer, then glue the Garden Green CS layer onto the front of the card base
17. Adhere the flowers at bottom right, using Stampin' Dimensionals where they cover the gap, and glue where they cover the raised layers.
18. Adhere Pale Papaya flower flourishes using a Mini Glue Dot (for the larger one) and glue (for the smaller ones).
