

Cheerful Daisies & a Mask

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – *Cheerful Daisies Bundle* (161296); *Wonderful Thoughts* (161899)
- **Cardstock** – Basic White (159276); Crushed Curry (131199); Basic Black (121045).
- **Stamp Pads** – Crushed Curry (147087); Versamark Pad (102283)
- **Misc.** – Blending Brushes (153611); Dimensionals (104430) Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Heat Tool (129053); Stampin' Emboss Powders Basics (155554); Artistic Mix Masks (159178); Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder (161600); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Bakers Twine Essentials Pack (155475)

Measurements:

- Crushed Curry: 4 ¼" x 11" and front mat 3" x 4 ¼"
- Basic White: (2) 3 ½" x 3 ½" for Daisies, (2) 4" x 5 ¼" One to be Embossed and one for inside); Stenciled Piece 2 7/8" x 4 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Die Cut two sets of Daisies using Basic White Cardstock.
2. Cut one set of Daisies apart.
3. Color centers of Daisies on the attached cluster and the individual Daisies.
4. Using Dimensionals offset the separate Daisies on top of the cluster. Set aside.
5. Emboss White mat using the Exposed Brick 3D Embossing folder and attach to card base.
6. Use your stencil over your smaller White mat at an angle, use a Post It note or washi to hold stencil in place, use your Blending Brushes to add Color. Once finished attach to your colored mat and then to the Embossed White Mat.
7. Add White Bakers Twine around the Stenciled Mat.
8. Attach the Sunflowers using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
9. Heat Emboss the Sentiment onto small Black piece of Cardstock using Versamark, White Embossing Powder and Heat Tool. Attach with Dimensionals
