

# Counting Sheep

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Counting Sheep\* (156591), SALE-A-BRATION thru 9-30-21
- **Card Stock** – Bumblebee (153007); Granny Apple Green (146990); Basic White (159276); Sweet Stockings Designer Series Paper (156281)
- **Stamp Pads** – Tuxedo Black Memento (132708); Granny Apple Green (147095)
- **Misc.** – Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Blends ~ Crumb Cake Light, Flirty Flamingo Light, Smoky Slate Dark; Cute Stars Adhesive Backed Sequins (156484, page 51 HC); Silicone Craft Sheet (127853, page 167 AC)

## Measurements:

- Bumblebee: 8 ½" x 5 ½" scored at 4 ¼" (Card Base)
- Sweet Stockings Designer Paper: 4" x 5 ¼"
- Granny Apple Green: 3" x 3 ¾"
- Basic White: 2 ¾" x 3 ½"

## Instructions :

1. Adhere the designer paper to the base card.
2. Stamp standing up sheep on Silicon Sheet using Memento Black.
3. Lay the white panel over the stamped image so the sheep will be on the left side once it is lifted up. Rub over the inked image with your fingers.\*
4. Stamp the grass with Granny Apple Green ink. Stamp the second sheep.
5. Color the sheep with the blends.
6. Adhere layers to the base card.
7. Stamp sheep on your envelope using the Silicone Sheet again, color with blends.
8. Add sentiment inside, adhere. Add stars. Enjoy!
