

Friendly Gnomes Valentine



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Friendly Gnomes (160714), page 40 Mini Catalog
- **Card Stock** – Orchid Oasis (159267); Perfectly Penciled 12" X 12" Designer Series Paper (159244); Parakeet Party (159259); Basic White (159276); Fluid 100 Watercolor Paper (149612)
- **Stamp Pads** – Daffodil Delight (147094); Parakeet Party (159208); Petal Pink (147108); Memento (132708); Smoky Slate (147113); Orchid Oasis (159214); Old Olive (147090); Mango Melody (147093); Polished Pink (155712); Stazon black ink (101406)
- **Misc.** – Water Painters(151298); Matte Black Dots (154284); Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (150673); Gnomes Dies (159625); Layering Diorama Dies (155565); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Fine-Tip Glue Pen(138309); Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Orchid Oasis: 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" AND 1" x 3"
- Designer Paper: 4" x 5 ¼"
- Parakeet Party: 1 ½ x 5 ¼
- Basic White: approx. 3" x 4" for Diorama die

Instructions:

1. Adhere the Designer Paper to the card base.
2. Adhere the Parakeet Party cardstock to the Designer Paper.
3. Cut out the Basic White with the Diorama die. Stamp the bird on the top left with Stazon black ink. Watercolour the bird using Daffodil ink and the beak with Mango Melody. Adhere the shape to the card.
4. Stamp the greeting on the Orchid Oasis strip on the left-hand side. Adhere it to the card.
5. Stamp the 2 gnomes on a piece of Watercolor Paper.
6. Use the small Water Painter to watercolor the gnomes. I pressed the ink pad on to a stamping block, picked up a bit of water and pick up some colour from the block.



7. Once coloured, die-cut the gnomes using their coordinating dies. Add them to the card using Dimensionals.
8. Add a bit of Fine-Tip Glue Pen to the heart and the flower. (Tip: You can squeeze a bit of glue on a scrap paper, then pick it up using a toothpick if you want to ensure that the glue doesn't blob on the card). Let dry before touching.
9. Add some Matte Black Dots.
