Supplies:

- **Stamp Set** ~ Love Cats (160410)
- **Cardstock** – Basic White (159276); Balmy Blue (146982); Polished Pink (155710)
- **Paper** – Country Floral Lane 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper (160375)
- **Stamp Pads** – Memento Ink (132708)
- **Misc.** – Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stamparatus (146276); Stampin' Write Markers Assortments ~ Subtles (147156); Pastel Adhesive-Backed Sequins (160387); Tailor Made Tags Dies (155563); Framed Florets Dies (160623); Take Your Pick Tool (144107); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Measurements:

- Balmy Blue base card ~ 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- Basic White ~ 4" x 5" and scrap for the sentiment
- Polished Pink cardstock ~ 4" x 5"
- Country Floral Lane DSP ~ 4" x 5 ¼"

Instructions :

1. Adhere the designer series paper to the card front.
2. Using the Stamparatus repeatedly stamp the cat on basic white using Memento ink. I stamped my cat three times to get the color I wanted. Color the heart Balmy Blue.
3. Die cut the frame from Polished Pink cardstock.
4. Place the frame over the cat and trace the inside of the oval, fussy cut the cat oval.
5. Adhere the cat to the DSP using multipurpose glue. Adhere the frame over the cat with four mini glue dots under the largest part of the frame design.
6. Stamp sentiment and cut out with second smallest tag die ~ cut one end, turn cardstock around and cut the other end to create stitching. Adhere with Dimensionals.
7. Add smallest blue sequins using the Take Your Pick Tool.
