

Decorative Masks Card

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** — Something Fancy Bundle (160425)
- **Card Stock** — Basic White (159276); Polished Pink (155710)
- **Stamp Pads** — Polished Pink (155712); Granny Apple Green (144095)
- **Misc.** — Loveliest Layers Decorative Masks (160517); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Cane Weave 3D Embossing Folder (160580); Something Fancy Dies (160424); Blending Brushes: Large (153611), Small (160518); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Dragonfly Trinkets (160520); Flat Adhesive Backed Pearls (160449)

Measurements:

- Polished Pink: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- Basic White: 5 1/4" x 4" (3 pieces) plus small scrap for the sentiment.

Instructions:

- Score the Polished Pink card stock at 4 1/4". Adhere one of the Basic White panels inside the card front.
- Emboss another of the Basic White panels with the Cane Weave 3D embossing folder and adhere it to the card front.
- On the remaining Basic White panel, lay down the mask with the large floral opening and add a light color of Polished Pink over the whole mask using a large Blending Brush. Align the detailed overlay and add a heavier layer of Polished Pink ink. Align the Leaf masks and add

Granny Apple Green ink with a small Blending Brush using the same technique as above.

NOTE: I found it easier to tape the sets of masks together for easier alignment. Another tip is to use the “dull” side of the mask for adding ink to the card panels.

- Fussy cut the entire image (floral and leaves together) and adhere to the card with Stampin’ Dimensionals.
- Add a Dragonfly Trinket with a Mini Glue Dot and a Flat Adhesive Backed Pearl as shown.
- Stamp Happy Birthday from the Something Fancy stamp set and die cut with the small angled die. Adhere to the card with Multipurpose Liquid Glue and Stampin’ Dimensionals.
