

# Quiet Meadow Mini Cards

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## Supplies:

**Stamp Sets:** Quiet Meadow\* (155082)

**Inks:** 2021-2023 In Colors Classic Stampin' Pad Bundle (155638)

**Paper:** 2021-2023 In Colors 8 ½ x11' Cardstock Assortment (155643); Basic White Thick cardstock (159229); Basic White (159276); Vellum 8 ½ x11 Cardstock (101856)

**Other:** 3/8" Open Weave Ribbon in Fresh Freesia (155615) and Evening Evergreen (155573); Loose Flower Flourishes (155808); Meadow dies\* (155852); Stitched with Whimsy dies (155314); Meadow Moments embossing folder (153126); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Seal (152813); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

## Measurements:

- Basic White Thick: 2 pieces 3" x 6" scored in half for card base
- Basic White: 3 pieces 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"; scrap for flower die cuts and banner; ½ " strip for banner
- Fresh Freesia: 3"x 6" scored in half for card base; scrap for butterfly
- Polished Pink: 3"x 6" scored in half for card base; scrap for butterfly
- Soft Succulent: : 3" x 6" scored in half for card base; scrap for fern die cut
- Evening Evergreen: 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"
- Pale Papaya: 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"

## Instructions:

1. Score each 3" x 6" piece of cardstock at 3" and fold in half.
2. Using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and the Meadow dies:
  - cut 3 flowers, as shown, or of your choice, with Basic White cardstock.
  - cut 1 label using Basic White cardstock
  - cut 2 butterflies; 1 using Polished Pink cardstock and 1 using Fresh Freesia cardstock
  - cut 1 fern using Soft Succulent cardstock.

### Polished Pink card:

- a) Stamp the basic white square with 3 flowers in Polished Pink and adhere to card base.
- b) Emboss the vellum cardstock with the Meadow Moments embossing folder and adhere on an angle to card base. Hint: Use adhesive underneath where the sentiment and butterfly will be.
- c) Stamp the sentiment with Polished Pink ink to the right side of the die cut label. Trim the scalloped edge off of the left-hand side. Adhere using Stampin' Dimensionals as shown.
- d) Attach the Polished Pink Loose Flower Flourish with a mini glue dot and the butterfly with a Stampin' Dimensional.

### Fresh Freesia card:

- a) Stamp the basic white square with the flower image in Fresh Freesia, as shown.
- b) Tie a piece of Fresh Freesia ribbon around the bottom of the basic white square and tie in a knot. Cut the ends on an angle. Adhere to the card base.
- c) Adhere the butterfly with a Stampin' Dimensional.

### Soft Succulent card:

- a) Stamp the basic white square with the word stamps by inking only once with Soft Succulent ink. Continue to stamp the background without reinking the stamp. Repeat with the scattered dots stamp. Adhere to card base.
- b) Attach the fern

### Pale Papaya card:

- a) Using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, add a decorative border to the Pale Papaya square using the square Stitched with Whimsy die. Adhere to Basic White card base.
- b) Stamp the sentiment using Pale Papaya ink onto a ½ " strip of Basic White cardstock. Adhere with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- c) Adhere the flower die cut with the fine tip glue pen. Trim any excess.

### Evening Evergreen card:

- a) Stamp the Evening Evergreen square with the word stamps by inking only once with Evening Evergreen ink. Continue to stamp the background without reinking the stamp. Repeat with the scattered dots stamp. Stamp some small flowers randomly. Adhere to card base on an angle as shown.
- b) Cut approximately 2" of Evening Evergreen ribbon and attach near the bottom of card.
- c) Adhere the 1<sup>st</sup> flower die cut with the fine tip glue pen. Trim any excess.
- d) Use Stampin' Dimensionals beneath the flower and glue beneath the stem to attach the 2<sup>nd</sup> flower slightly on top of the 1<sup>st</sup> flower. Trim any excess.
